## Michelangelo: Drawings and poems at The British Museum

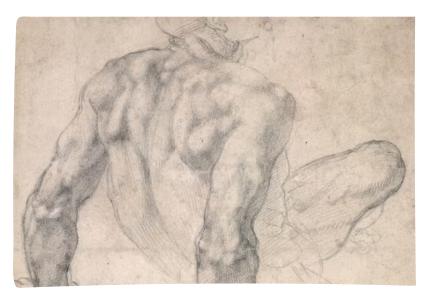
Join our FREE programme for people with early-stage dementia or mild cognitive impairment and their companions.
